

#### We are in the season of LENT

**Lent** is a season of 40 days, not counting Sundays, which began on Ash Wednesday (1 March) and ends on Holy Saturday (15 April). **Lent** comes from the Anglo-Saxon word "Lencten" which means "spring".

The season is a preparation for celebrating Easter. Historically, **Lent** began as a period of fasting, and preparation for baptism by converts and then became a time for penance by all Christians.

Because Sundays are always little Easters, the penitential spirit of **Lent** should be tempered with joyful expectation of the Resurrection.

The liturgical colour is **PURPLE**, the colour for penitence and preparation.
