Cantate Domino was formed in 1991. Its membership is interdenominational and currently consists of 18 experienced choristers from 8 churches of 4 different denominations. Cantate Domino has sung in numerous churches in Singapore and in churches in KL and Medan. It has sung to raise funds for Christian causes such as Alpha Singapore, SPH Pocket Money Fund, St Andrew's Autism Centre, St John's Home for the Aged, Methodist Welfare Services, and, last year, Cantate Domino sang to raise funds for El Shaddai Refugee Learning Centre in Klang, Malaysia. Cantate Domino believes that a good choral group is marked by the same truths as mark a good church, ie, the whole is greater than the sum of the parts, and the ability to make sounds is less important than the ability to listen.

Cantate meets at homes of members and is run by a 3 man Committee. As some of the group's members conduct in their home churches, conductorship of Cantate Domino is rotated.
