

Pastor:

Today, we celebrate an important milestone in the lives of these Primary 6s. In their studies, they have just completed their PSLE and will soon be making the transition into Secondary School. And here in Church, another transition awaits them as they graduate from the Children's Ministry into the Youth Ministry. We thank God for the dedication of the teachers and helpers of the Children's Ministry, in laying an important foundation in the lives of these teenagers. And as they move on into this new season of life, we want to continue to commit them to the Lord and to pray for them.

As our Church continues to focus on Discipleship, we believe that discipleship begins in the home, and this is where we have invited the Parents of each child to participate in this rite of passage, along with representatives from the Children's Ministry and Youth Ministry. Furthermore, the discipleship of the next generation is also the responsibility of the Church, and we would like to invite you as the TMC community, to be a part of this rite of passage by affirming your commitment to pray for them and to nurture them in their faith by your words, actions and example. Would you join me as we celebrate the rite of passage with them and commission them into this new season.

i. Pastor addresses the Children

Will you continue to walk with God daily, by committing to reading the Bible, praying and growing in the community of faith here in TMC?

We will.

ii. Pastor addresses the Parents/Guardians

Will you continue to disciple and nurture them in Christ's Holy Church, teaching them the Word of God diligently, and modelling for them a life of a disciple, that they may grow to love the Lord with all their heart, soul and might?

We will.

iii. Pastor addresses the Youth Leaders

Will you commit to caring and loving these teenagers entrusted to you, partnering alongside their parents to teach them the Word of God, grounding them in this community of faith, and discipling them towards Christlikeness?

We will.

iv. Pastor addresses the Congregation

Will you nurture these teenagers now before you in your care, committing yourselves to pray for them, mentoring and setting before them an example of being and living as a community of disciples?

With God's help, we will surround these teenagers with a community of love and faith. We covenant to build them in their relationship with God, and testify of His mighty acts with them, that they may in turn commend your works to future generations.

Each graduating P6 will receive a Bible by their parents, a certificate by a Children's Ministry representative and a Welcome Gift by a Youth Ministry representative.

Each Bible contains an inscription by their parent/guardian written prior to this ceremony, offering words of affirmation and prayer for their child/ward. The presentation of the Bible signifies the commitment of the parent to continue teaching them the Word of God, and nurturing them in the ways of Christ. It also symbolizes the responsibility of the teenager to begin working out their own faith, and feeding themselves with God's Word.
