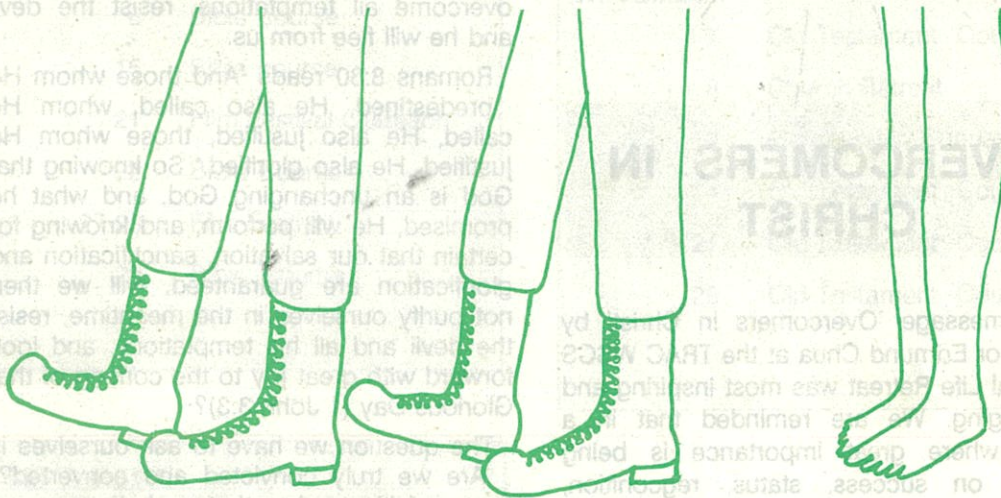

DO YOU LIKE CHANGE? Some love it. Others hate it. But we all know that change is inevitable. The point is to change for the better.

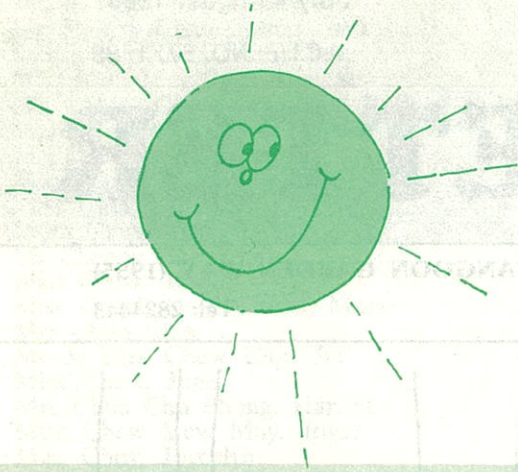

OVERCOMERS IN CHRIST

The message 'Overcomers in Christ' by Pastor Edmund Chua at the TRAC WSCS Spiritual Life Retreat was most inspiring and challenging. We are reminded that in a world where great importance is being placed on success, status, recognition, security, comforts, credentials, qualifications, self-worth etc., we who are truly Christians must know that we are in God's control, and that we should overcome our worldliness and nail the 'self' to the Cross. He also reminded us that we being in Christ are more than conquerors against all odds.

At our small group discussion afterwards, we came to one conclusion that in order to overcome, we must first be truly convicted and converted, believing in Christ, not because He can offer us Heaven, comfort in distress or citizenship of His Kingdom, healing in sickness, or believe in Him as a kind of beliefism, but that, we believe, because we can see our own state of sinfulness, helplessness and hopelessness, and we repent of our sins and turn to God, who provided us a way of salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. It is only when we are truly converted that the Holy Spirit will live in our spirit and control the whole of us.

We have to understand and realise that a true Christian is being translated from the

realm and reign of sin to the realm and reign of grace; as such, he is no longer controlled by sin, no longer slaves of sin, he is now a free man in God's Kingdom, and if he sins, he sins as a child of God in His Kingdom and is wounding God's love. True, our old man was dead and buried at Calvary, but our body is still in this world, and as long as we are here, there will be temptations, so we have to **exercise our will** not to fall into temptations and sin, and with the strength from the Lord, we can overcome all temptations, resist the devil and he will flee from us.

Romans 8:30 reads 'And those whom He predestined, He also called, whom He called, He also justified, those whom He justified, He also glorified.' So knowing that God is an unchanging God, and what he promised, He will perform, and knowing for certain that our salvation, sanctification and glorification are guaranteed, will we then not purify ourselves in the meantime, resist the devil and all his temptations, and look forward with great joy to the coming of that Glorious Day (1 John 3:3)?

The question we have to ask ourselves is "Are we truly convicted and converted?" for true faith requires that we believe everything God has said about Himself, and also everything He has said about us, and until we believe that we are as bad as God says we are, we can never believe that He will do for us what He says He will do. Do we desire things above? Do we hunger and thirst after righteousness? Do things of the world grow strangely dim to us? Let us really look into ourselves and search our hearts and ask what is my relationship with God? Have we valued **gifts** above the **fruit of the spirit** and go after miracles, signs and wonders, forgetting that the most needed miracle is the **inner transformation** from self-will to absolute and joyful surrender. If we are Christ-centred, and give our attention, first of all, to the written Word of God, that He has gone to such lengths to provide for all mankind, we will know him well, truly love Him and draw strength from Him daily. We will remember who we are now, and whom we have believed, knowing fully well that His grace is sufficient for us and His strength is made perfect in weakness, and that in Christ we are more than conquerors.

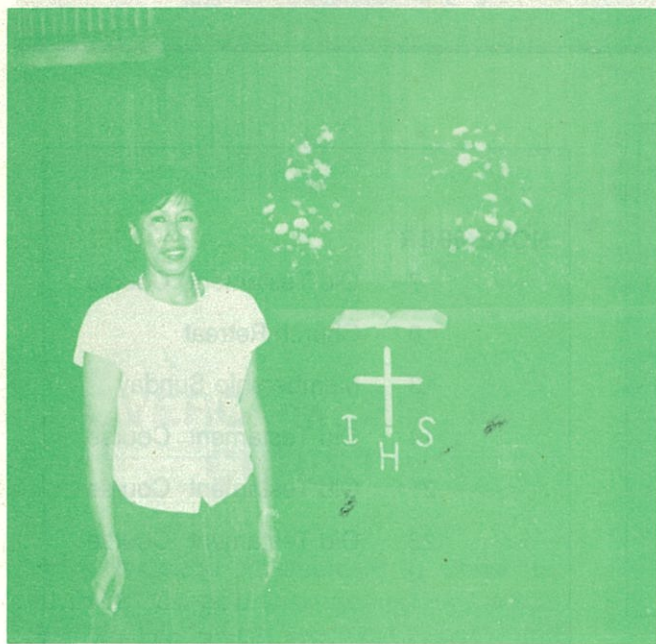

GUEST PREACHERS



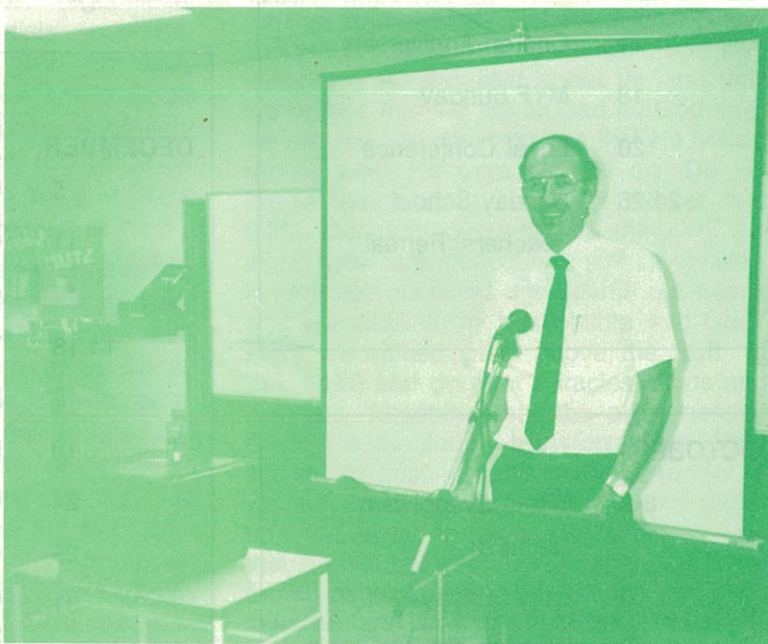
Mrs Esther Wong, familiar to TMC's lady members, was our church's guest speaker on Mother's Day this year.

Mr. Brian Cummins, Asst General Director, Youth for Christ, recently shared the Word from the old testament book of Habakkuk.

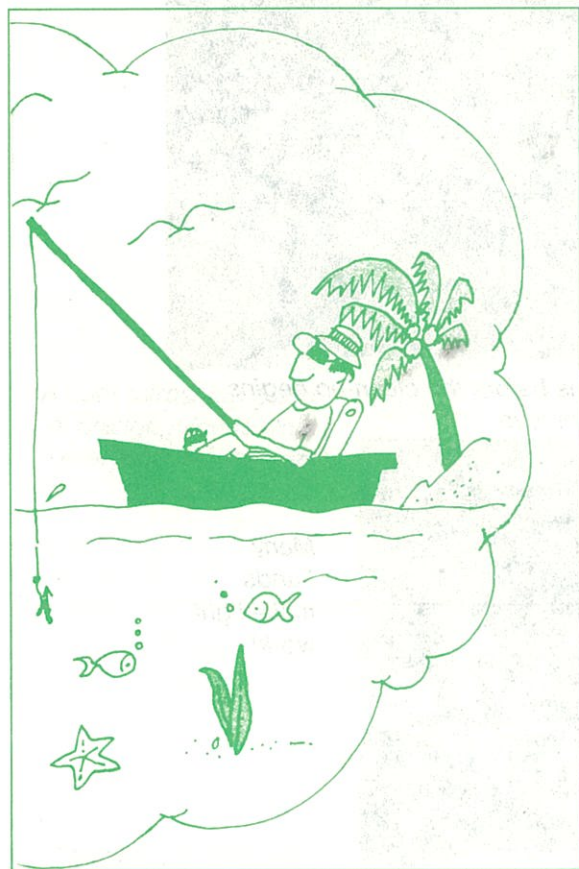

Most of all, the Lord is to be praised for blessing the group with His presence, journey mercies and wisdom to the organisers and leaders of this retreat.



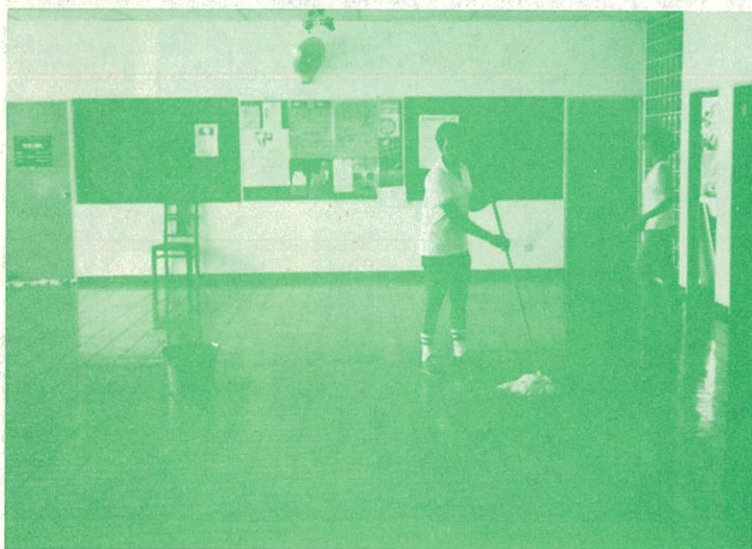

The boss gathers his flock for final instructions before the clean-up begins. About 75 members turned up for this labour of love.

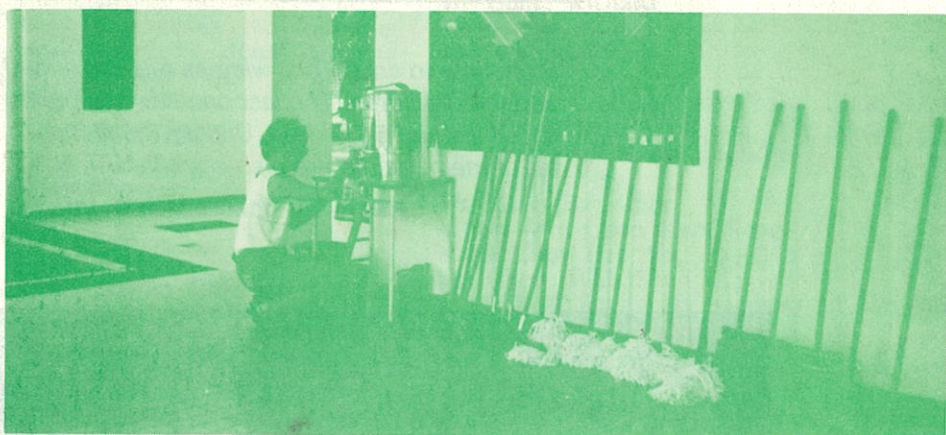

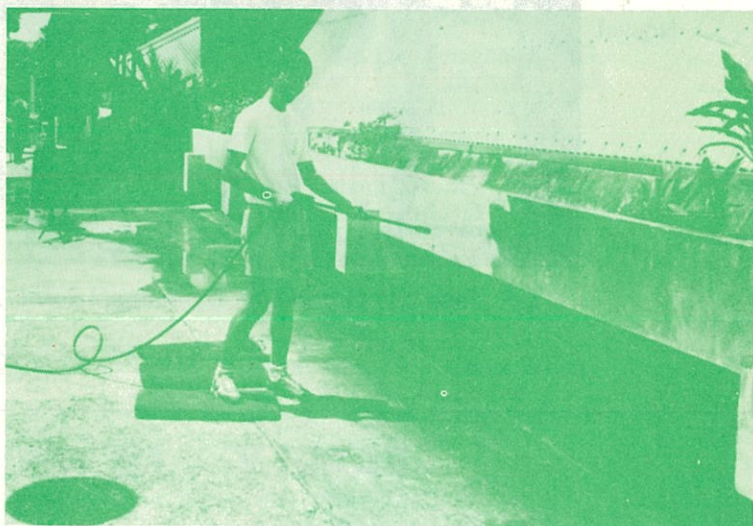
