### Season of Epiphany

We are in the new Church Season of Epiphany. The word, “Epiphany”, comes from the Greek word meaning “manifestation” or “showing forth”. This is the season when we celebrate Jesus Christ “shown forth” or “manifested” (epiphanized) to all as Saviour of the World.

The liturgical colour is **green**, the colour of the world of nature, signifying the universality of Christ’s redemptive purpose and power.
