Stripping of the Altar

The altar coverings and decorations are removed at the end of the Maundy Thursday Service to symbolize the abandonment of Jesus by His disciples and the stripping of Jesus by the soldiers prior to His crucifixion.

This, like the darkness often incorporated into a Good Friday service, represents the humiliation of Jesus and the consequences of sin as a preparation for the celebration of new life and hope that is to come on Easter Sunday.
