ACTSpand (Crate-of-Blessings)

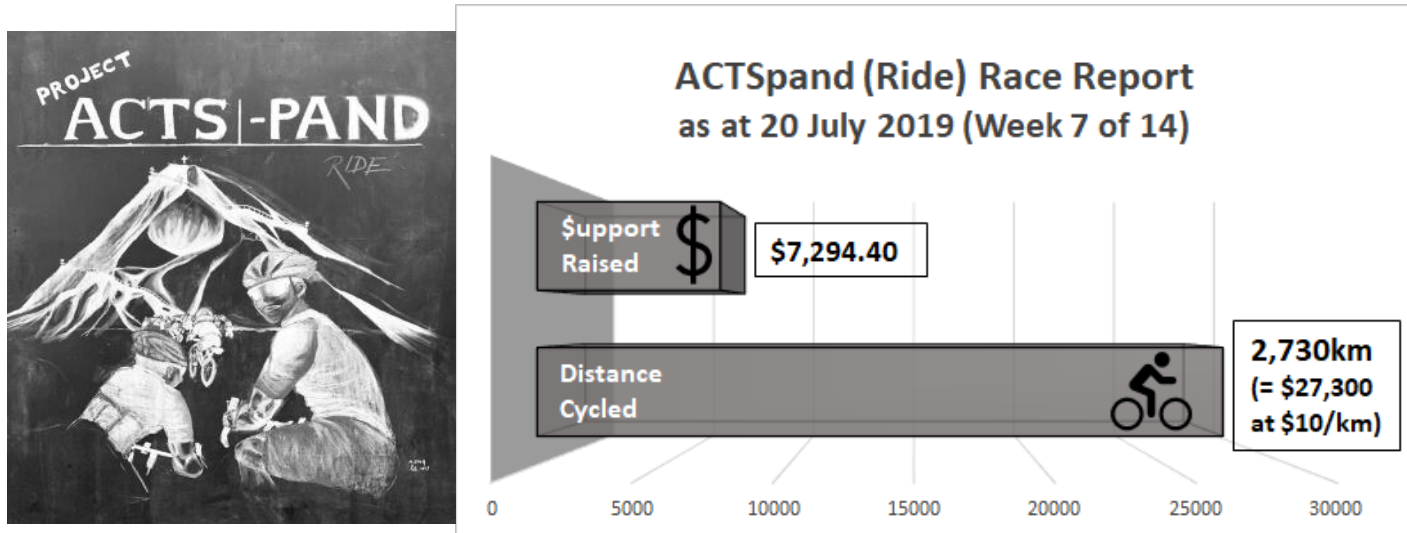
