



Trinity Theological College: Fact Sheet



- Trinity Theological College was founded in 1948. It was during the Second World War that missionaries interned at Changi Prison envisioned the establishment of a union college which was later given its present name. Through the support of partner-churches, friends and donors, TTC continues to fulfill her mission of "equipping the saints and engaging the world" (Ephesians 4:12, 13).
- Students at TTC may choose to study in either the English or the Chinese programme. Both basic and advanced degrees are offered by the College. TTC also helps to train new lecturers for seminaries in Asia through its Doctor of Theology programme.
- TTC's library holds one of the best collections of theological books and periodicals in the region. In addition to its collection strength of more than 108,000 items, the library is supplemented by e-resources including journals, databases and full text online publications from leading academic publishers.
- TTC's faculty members come from a wide spectrum of churches. Besides lecturing, they contribute to the growth and witness of the Church through publications, regular preaching in churches, and engagement with contemporary issues from a Christian perspective. Some of their writings may be found on the website of ETHOS Institute of Public Christianity, and also in the TTC newsletter "Trumpet" which is available for download from the College's website.
- TTC continues to offer a wide range of evening courses for lay people. Through "EQUIP: A TTC Lay-Training Initiative", the College offers the Certificate in Christian Ministry (CCM) and Licentiate in Christian Ministry (LCM) programmes. In partnership with the Anglican Diocese and the Singapore Centre for Global Missions, TTC also offers the Certificate in Mission Practice (CMP) programme for Christians who wish to serve a shorter term as missionaries.
