Preparing Yourself for Church@Home:

We understand this is a new concept and it may seem a little strange at first, but we believe that we serve an omni-present God. James 4:8 teaches us that when we draw near to Him, He will draw near to us. So we believe our posture is important to help us encounter God wherever we may be.

So whether you're doing Church@Home as an individual, a family or a small group, here are some ways that you can prepare your heart for Church@Home.

a) Be intentional about your settings.

Set up a conducive and distraction-free physical environment for this (i.e living room). Also, be intentional about setting aside around 1 hour of uninterrupted time for this (i.e Silence your phone). Remember that this is Church and Worship, and should be approached with reverence.

b) Engage fully throughout the service.

Engage in worship as if you are worshipping in a normal service. In prayer, participate accordingly and follow the promptings of the prayer leader on video. During the message, consider taking notes as you hear God's Word.

c) Be expectant for God to meet you wherever you are.

Remember that God is not confined to a building nor a venue nor even having a live musical accompaniment present. He wants to meet us wherever we are at. The disciples had an encounter with the Holy Spirit in an upper room of a home, and we believe God is able and wants to do the same wherever you are too!

Children's Ministry@Home

Our Children's Ministry team will continue to partner with parents and guardians to disciple their children. Each weekly Church@Home package will contain a CM@Home bundle, which includes worship songs and activities that parents/guardians can do with their children.

CM@Home should not take longer than 45 mins, and can be conducted before the adults begin their own programme. Do note that the worksheets were not designed for children to complete on their own; Hence, parental assistance and guidance is necessary.

If you're meeting in a small group setting with other families with young children, consider appointing one parent to lead CM@Home that week.

Since this is a new initiative, we have also provided an infographic in the CM@Home bundle to guide and support parents/guardians in using our resources.
