Here are some important things you will need to take note of as you return:

- 1. Entry is on a ticketed basis, and tickets are on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- 2. All our in-person services currently require worshippers to either be fully-vaccinated or have undergone a Pre-Event Test (PET) with an authorised test provider 24 hours before the expected end of the service. Children 12 years old and below who want to attend in-person services are exempted from these requirements.
- 3. At the check-in point, please get ready (a) your NRIC or any other Photo ID; <u>and</u> (b) your internet-enabled mobile device with the TraceTogether App installed, or your TraceTogether Token. Primary school children should also bring their Student Card and Token for admission into the worship service.
- 4. Do aim to arrive 20 mins before the service begins as you familiarise yourself with the new check-in process.

We regret that we will not be able to admit you into the worship venue if (1) - (3) above are not complied with. In particular, we are unable to accept any other methods of checkin. If you have any queries about the check-in process, please contact the church office during office hours before the weekend.
